Notice of Availability: Asbestos Management Plan

As provided under the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act, (AHERA –EPA 40 CFR 793), the Fulton City School District hereby makes known the steps it has undertaken to comply with AHERA and the availability of asbestos management plans.

1. Beginning in 1989, all district owned facilities were inspected for asbestos and management plans were developed for each building according to the requirements of AHERA. The District conducts reinspections every three years. Onondaga-Cortland-Madison BOCES completed the 2007 AHERA Triennial inspection and update to the asbestos management plans.
2. Periodic surveillance of asbestos containing building material is conducted every six months.
3. The custodial and maintenance staff have undergone asbestos awareness training.
4. All response actions taken are within federal and state guidelines.
