

**ACCEPTING STUDENTS FOR INDEPENDENT ACTIVITIES**

The Board of Education recognizes that independent activities for students, including sports, are an integral and desirable part of the district's secondary program.

The Board of Education believes that independent activities provided by the District shall be open to other districts that do not provide those opportunities. The Board of Education further believes that students of the Fulton School district should be provided the opportunity to participate in independent activities sponsored by other districts.

Therefore, the Board of Education directs the Superintendent of Schools to develop a regulation that would allow Fulton students to participate in independent activities offered by neighboring school districts as well as allow students from other districts to participate in activities provided by the Fulton City School District.
